(Institute Level Seats)

Candidates, who have applied to this college for admission to F.E. courses and whose name appear in the final merit lists, should note that there will a counselling round on 13th & 14th of July 2018 to fill up the seats in the Institute level category. Please Note: If there are any vacancies still available at the end of the round on 14/07/2018, the same will be put up on the college website by 11.00 am on 16/07/2018 & accordingly there will be an extended round on 17/07/2018, for which the schedule will also be put up on 16/07/2018 itself. Candidates are advised to look for the final seat position before reporting to the college on 17/07/2018.

Candidates are advised to keep all the documents ready (originals + two photocopies) along with the Demand Draft /Pay Order of Rs. 1,57,706/- drawn in favour of “**The Principal, Dwarkadas J. Sanghvi College of Engineering, Mumbai**”, while reporting for admission.

Candidates, who have completed their 12th standard from a board other than Maharashtra state board will have to produce an additional Demand Draft/ Pay Order of Rs. 1000/- drawn in favour of “**The Principal, Dwarkadas J. Sanghvi College of Engineering, Mumbai**” for the purpose of verification process for obtaining the eligibility from the University of Mumbai.

Please note that the list of relevant documents required for securing admission has been put up on the college website on 28th June, 2018. You may note that the DD & the list of documents are to be made compulsorily available at the time of admission, without which the admission will not be offered.

You are required to report, sharp at the reporting time given above, at the seminar hall on the 3rd floor of the college building for this counselling round.

Candidates will be called as per the merit order and if at that time, they do not possess the requested documents and the D.D./Pay Order, that particular seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate on the spot. Candidates are requested to promptly produce the required documents & the DD as applicable at the time of their admission.

Candidates are clearly advised to note that the seat will be allotted to them, only in case a vacant seat is available as and when their turn comes. If the seats are already filled up, by the time the turn of the candidate comes in the order of merit, they will have to wait for further vacancies, if any.

Please Note :- Candidates, who have already secured admission in the previous round (ILS) and wishes to upgrade their branch in this counselling round (subject to availability of vacancy) are required to bring the original Fee Receipt (issued in previous round) as well as a demand draft of Rs.1000/- (transfer fee) at the time of admission.

Candidates, who may have secured their admission through the DTE (CAP) admission process and wish to now take admission through the ILS category will have to produce a new Demand Draft/Pay Order of Rs. 1,57,706/- (plus a DD of Rs. 1,000/-, if they are from Non-HSC board) as well as all other relevant documents/retention certificate at the time of admission.
