I. Events

1. Tech Rush

- As engineering students we are driven by innovation and passion for technology. The event ‘fuelled this passion and became a cherishing experience for the participants to apply their practical skills to the usual components and circuits like **DLD Logic, development of Analog electronic Circuits.**
- There were a total of 15 teams competing and each team was represented by 3 members
- it comprised of 4 rounds. Rounds like bread **board implementation and circuit identification** had the imagination of the tech buff students soaring to another dimension.
- There were two trophies awarded to the winner and the runner up team by the Head of Department

2. VFX-Workshop.

- Animation is the amplification of an idea through simplification and abstraction,
- It was conducted by the senior faculty of Arena Animation Academy and attended by 106 students from all departments and the years of engineering.
- Source materials of the workshop were the four softwares: Adobe Shoot 6; Premiere 6; Photoshop 6; After Effects 6, which were made available to the participants in advance of the workshop date.
- The courses covered were stop motion, tracking, chroma set-up, green or blue screen and double role.
- Animation is timeless and future proof , it helps to bridge the gap between the annoyingly complex reality and the unimaginable reality

3. Sixth Sense Workshop

- Imagine bubbles floating before your eyes, filled with cool information about stuff you see on the street. Science fiction? Nope. It's augmented reality. The Google glass was invented using this technology
- Attended by 42 students and conducted by experts from Technophilia.
- The students were taught hand gesture controlling of power point presentations, music players and many other applications. Each of the teams were given a webcam which would detect their hand gestures and control their laptops.

4. Dj Spark:

- A state level project competition was held on 11th April,2014 . Students from all over Maharashtra come forward and submit their projects. A large number of the BE's from ever department compete with their final year projects.
- It was a huge success with over 70+30 teams from other colleges within and outside Mumbai participated, showcasing their technical knowledge and anticipating a win. A total of 35+14 teams cleared the review process and got selected by the senior faculty of EXTC Department.
- An ISBN-No. was allotted to each of the projects.
- Projects focusing not only on Electronics and Telecommunication but also topics which are IT based projects which could be implemented commercially.
- The preparations this year also build an air of a successful event with a large turnout of participants and spectators all in awe of the talent at display.

II. Value Added Program

Book Bank

- Book Bank is an initiative made by IETE that makes reference books available to students at 10% of the original cost.
- It improved the core competency and to strengthen the teaching ability. These books are referred by the faculty members and hence it makes the studying process efficient and helps increase the student's technological knowledge about the subject.
- It also helps build a foundation of the concepts that could enhance the practical skills required in the future.
