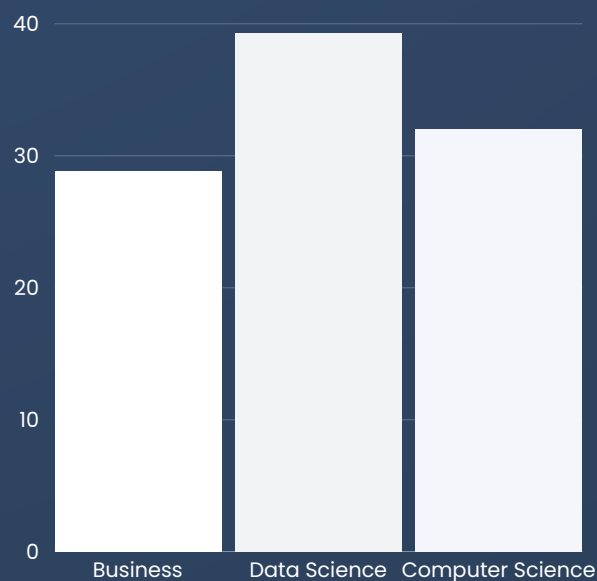

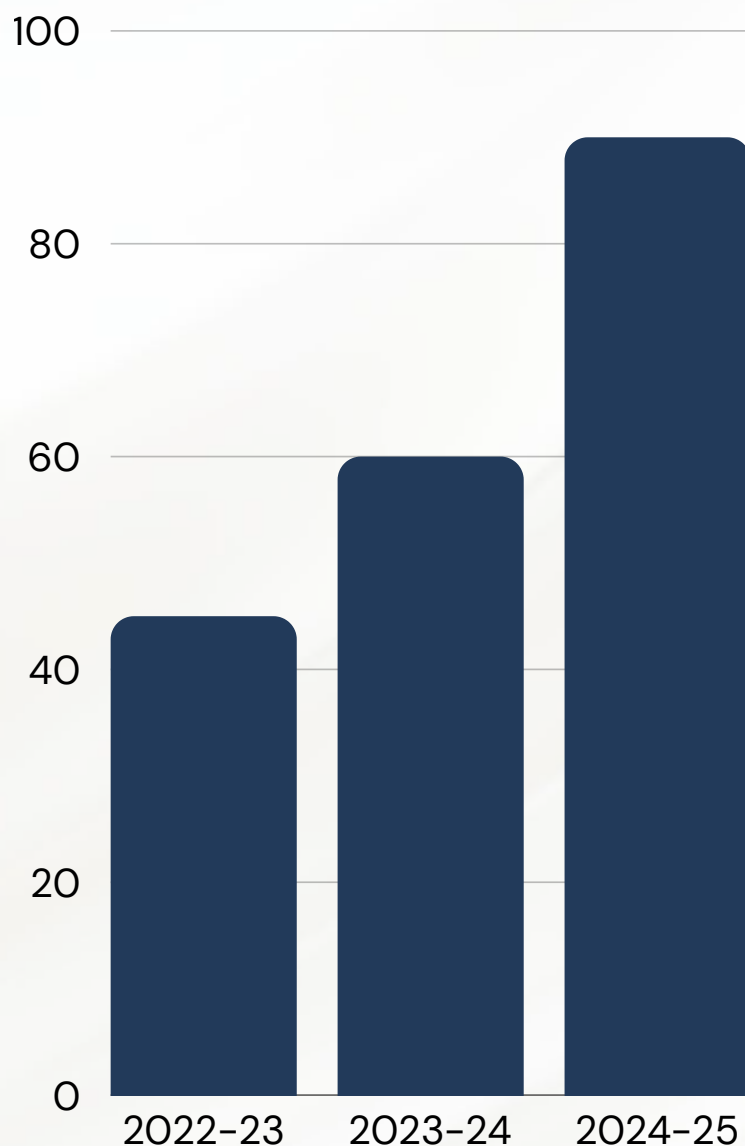
Expectations of the external engagement Program
