EBC Scholarship Academic Year 2021-22

Eligible students of the college, who wish to avail the EBC benefit during the academic year 2021-22, will have to submit the online application (Fresh / Renewal) on Mahadbt portal as soon as the semester of academic year 2021-22 begins.

Please refer Mahadbt portal for the Eligibility conditions and required documents.

The below mentioned documents needs to be kept ready for physical submission in the college, immediately in the beginning of the Odd semester of academic year 2021-22. The physical documents verification date will be notified later.

- 1) DTE CAP allotment cum admission letter.
- 2) Original Income certificate from Tahasildar office for financial year 2020-21. (Annual Income less then Rs. 8.00 lakhs).
*If Income certificate is not in the name of the father, relevant documents like : father's death certificate/Divorce paper are additionally required.
- 3) Affidavit / Undertaking as per the format in the below mentioned link on Rs. 100/- non judicial stamp paper ([Undertaking Link](#))
- 4) Photocopy of Ration card for identifying number of children in family, as only 2 children are eligible for the scholarship benefit.
- 5) Declaration Certificate of parents/guardians about number of children beneficiaries. (format on MAHADBT Portal)
- 6) Marksheet of Previous year. (self-attested copy)
- 7) Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra State.
- 8) Aadhar seeded Bank account details of student along with Passbook 1st page copy and Mobile Number. ([Bank details format link](#))
- 9) Aadhar card copy.

All the documents submitted in the college will be verified and the outcome of verification of the acceptance or rejection will be conveyed to the students through email, as available in the SAP records. Accordingly, students will have to pay the college fees as per verification outcome of their application.
