Academic Year: 2018-19

1. The department hosted an **alumni meet** on 2nd February 2019. 54 alumni attended the meet.
2. The IT Department along with Computer Engineering Department organized **DJASCII 2019**, a state level project competition on 30th March, 2019.

Academic Year: 2017-18

1. The department hosted an **alumni meet** on 3rd February 2018. 61 alumni attended the meet.
2. 10 students from IT department were selected for the main round of **SEED IT IDOL**, Mumbai on 20th March, 2018. Shreeya Agarwal from SEIT was selected from the college among top 10 students. Shreeya was also declared the **1st runner up** of SEED IT IDOL, Mumbai and was awarded with 1TB WD hard disk.
3. 3 teams from IT department participated in the 36 hour **Smart India Hackathon 2018** which took place on 30th and 31st March, 2018. The details of the teams are:
 - a. Team 'Syncx' comprising of TEIT students Sanika Biwalkar, Raj Patel, Aniket Mhatre, Pratmesh Mhapsekar, Mandar Mhapsekar and Ronak Doshi with faculty mentor Prof. Archana Nanade and industry expert Mr. Sahil Mhapsekar. Their problem statement was "ICT as a new technology in Disaster management and Information Technology in emergency preparedness and Response" under the Ministry of Assam. The team SyncX secured the **1st runner-up** prize of Rs.75,000 at the center.
 - b. Team 'The Code Rebels' comprising of BEIT students Karan Savla, Vaibhav Shah, Nahush Raichura, Pratik Aher, Darsh Shah and Rishi Joshi with faculty Mentor Prof. Amit Sahu. Their problem statement was 'GIS Based Mobile Application for Emergency Response System for Disaster Situation' under the ministry of Arunachal Pradesh. The Code Rebels were one of the **top 11 teams**.
 - c. Team 'The GodJob' comprising of TEIT students Tanuj Bohra, Aditya Shinde, Meet Nandu, Saifil Momin, Yashi Suba Dhvani Kansara with mentor Lekhraj Varshney and faculty Mentor Prof. Dinesh S. Tharwani. Their problem

statement was 'C2C based platform for Crowd funding for Women and child Empowerment' under Ministry of Women and Child development.

4. The IT department jointly with Computer Department organized '**DJASCI 2018**', a state level project completion on 13th April 2018. We received 150 entries for the competition of which 80 were shortlisted.

Academic Year: 2016-17

1. IT Department was declared as "**Best Department**" in the college on Annual Day held on 6th April 2017 at B. J. Hall, Vile Parle (W).
2. CSI National Executive Committee (Execom) had declared the award as "**Best Active CSI Student Branch**" for DJ-CSI Student Chapter in the academic year 2016-17. This award is declared at the National Level where the committee had selected 10 Best CSI Student Chapters from India and out of these 10, 3 are from Maharashtra (D. J. Sanghvi COE, Thadomal COE and Sandip Polytechnic Nashik).
3. The projects namely "Infant Growth Tracker" and "Wheat Categorization" of BEIT were selected (approx. 850 entries from 6 domains) for **first round** of Zee Young Innovator Award 2016. Their reporter was in the college premises on 15th Feb, 2017 to shoot the working model along with a small presentation of the project so that final jury member can understand the same.
4. With the tremendous support of the faculties from the departments of Computer Engineering and Information Technology of the college, DJ-CSI co-hosted the 2nd edition of **DJ ASCII** – a state level project competition along with DJACM student chapter on 1st April, 2017.

Academic Year: 2015-16

1. IT Department won the **2nd position at Inter-Department Competition** held in D.J. Sanghvi College of Engineering in April 2016.

1. The Department achieved a **BEST STUDENT CHAPTER AWARD (CSI)** for the academic year 2014-15.
2. The Department of IT and Computer Engineering had successfully organized an **International Conference on Advanced Computing Technologies and Applications (ICACTA 2015)** on 26th and 27th March 2015 at The Juhu Club, Andheri (W). The conference got overwhelming response and brought together over 110 professionals, researchers, practitioners, and educators from countries such as India, USA, Saudi Arabia and South Africa. From within India, papers were received from Maharashtra, Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tripura, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka to name a few. They collaborated to share their experiences, to learn from one another and to debate the future development of advanced computing domain. The conference was structured around facilitated presentations, webinars, and plenary speakers to allow all participants to enter into practical discussion. It also helped the audience to learn from the diversity of experience that participants brought to the conference. We are very happy to say that ICACTA 2015 has achieved what it had aimed for by receiving an overwhelming response of 242 international and national papers, out of which 103 were selected after a rigorous review by our panel of expert reviewers. We had list of eminent personalities from academics, research, and industry as our advisory committee with 13 international members and 24 national members.
3. The Department had organized a **POSTER PRESENTATION** of Final Year Projects on 9th April at DH1, 5th floor from 10am to 4pm. More than 100 SE and TE students had enthusiastically interacted with the final year students to get project idea.
