HACKNICHE EVENT REPORT

Date of the event: 17th and 18th February 2023 Number of

Participants: 180, 42 teams

Description of the Event:

The event brought together talented and ambitious students from various colleges like, Sardar Patel Institute of Technology, K. J. Somaiya College of Engineering, Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Technology, Thadomal Shahani Engineering College, Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues College of Engineering, Mukesh Patel School of Technology Management & Engineering and many more, to collaborate and create innovative solutions to real-world problems. The event provided a platform for participants to showcase their skills and innovative ideas and was an excellent opportunity to bring together individuals from diverse backgrounds to collaborate and solve real-world problems.

Hackniche was open to individuals from all backgrounds, including students, entrepreneurs and professionals. The event managed to attract 1200+ participant registrations, out of which 180, or 42 teams, were shortlisted.

The event was divided into six domains, including AI/ML, WebApp, IoT, Blockchain and Social Cause with each domain having specific challenges to solve. Participants were given a specific problem statement or theme to work on within their respective domains. The problem statements or themes included:

- PS 1 - Hackathon Team Selection

- PS 2 - Personal finance management system
- PS 3 - Easing the lives of servicemen
- PS 4 - Online Verification of Certificates using Blockchain
- PS 5 - Automated News Fetcher
- PS 6 - Intrusion / Theft Detection system

The solutions created by participants were evaluated based on criteria, such as innovation, feasibility and impact by a panel of judges consisting of experts in the respective domains. The panel of judges included Sandip Patel from NetXD, Deepak Tiwari from JP Morgan, Ankit Gupta from Morgan Stanley, Lekhraj Varshney from JP Morgan, Pranav Chitale from JP Morgan, Ujala Jha from JP Morgan, and Vatsal Thakkar from Mastercard.

Outcomes:

The solutions created by participants were evaluated based on criteria, such as innovation, feasibility and impact. A panel of judges, consisting of experts in the respective domains, evaluated the solutions and selected the winning teams.

At the end of the 24-hour hackathon event, the panel of judges evaluated the solutions created by participants and selected the winning teams. The winning teams were awarded prizes, which included:

Total cash prizes worth INR 1,00,000 + goodies as well as internship opportunities

Certificate of excellence for top 3 teams

Certificate of distinction for top 6 teams

Certificate of participation to all teams

All in all, Hackniche was a resounding success, achieving its goals and objectives. Participants were able to leverage their skills and expertise to generate innovative solutions to the challenges presented. The event also fostered collaboration and networking among participants, leading to potential future partnerships and collaborations.


