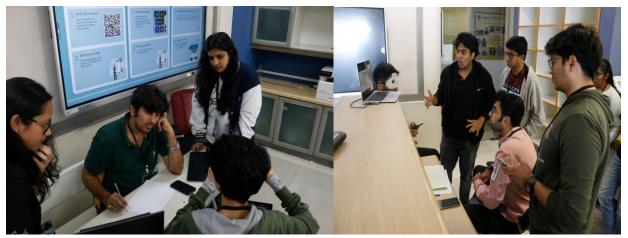
The day of the event started with an Inauguration ceremony, Principal Dr. Hari Vasudevan, HOD Computer Department Dr. Meera Narvekar, ACM Convener Dr. Narendra Shekokar and Faculty coordinators Dr. Kiran Bhowmick and Dr. Aruna Gawde shared words of wisdom with the participants. Dr. Hari Vasudevan's speech inspired us to look beyond what is fathomable and draw lines of control wherever necessary.



The coding round started at 11:30 am and buzzed with ideation among participants to produce the best of ideas. There were two mentoring rounds, at 4 pm and 11 pm respectively, wherein senior students from B.Tech. gave insights on improvement to the teams.

The presentation round was filled with excitement and enthusiasm of the participants about displaying their project. Team Pied Pipers (TSEC, Mumbai) emerged victorious, followed by team Syndicate (DJSCE) and team K Means Killers (DJSCE) as 2nd runner up.

The participants were awarded cash prizes Rs. 75,000, Rs. 50,000 and Rs. 30,000. Additionally, winners showered with goodies from sponsors Haphazard. The judges found many teams promising and 4 teams have been offered internship opportunities at Airrchip.
