F.Y. B.Tech Admissions: 2021-22

Students, who have been allotted admissions by the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Government of Maharashtra (CAP Round-I).

1. Candidates, who have been allotted their seat through the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Government of Maharashtra: **CAP Round-I** for the Academic Year 2021-22, are required to fill in the (online) admission form, which will be available on the college website from 04th December 2021.
2. Read the instructions carefully, before filling up the form.
3. They should further note that they need to report to the college anytime between 10.00 a.m. to 01.00 p.m. or 02.00 p.m. to 04.00 p.m., from **04th December, 2021 onwards till 07th December, 2021** for completing the admission formalities.
4. Please enter the CAP registration number (EN..) and click "Continue" in the online form.
5. It then displays the options as below:
 - I. Create Application [if already applied in D.J. Sanghvi College for Institute level Category, click this option, enter the application number (600.....) and then click NEXT].
 - II. Create CAP/TFWS applicant [if not applied in D.J. Sanghvi College for Institute level category] (click this option and then click NEXT).
6. Please check the allotted branch and category before filling the form. In case of any discrepancy, you are instructed to report to the college.
7. Please fill in all the mandatory fields, i.e. fields marked with (*).
8. Check the information entered by you in the application form carefully, before submitting the form.
9. Once the application is submitted, no changes can be made thereafter.
10. After the submission of form, the candidate has to come to the college with required original documents + two sets of photocopies and the requisite fees payable through Demand draft/Pay order of the amount mentioned in the table given below, drawn in favour of "**Dwarkadas J. Sanghvi College of Engineering**" for confirming the admission.
11. Candidates, who have completed their 12th standard from a board other than Maharashtra state board will have to produce an **additional** Demand Draft/ Pay Order of Rs. 1,320/- drawn in favour of "**Dwarkadas J. Sanghvi College of Engineering**" for the purpose of verification process to obtain the eligibility from the University of Mumbai (as given in the table below).

12. Students belonging to various categories, such as OBC/EBC/SEBC/VJ/NT/SBC etc., should note that if their annual income is more than 8 lakhs for the financial year 2020-21, they will have to pay fees, as that of the General/GCLM category students.
13. **Candidates, who have already secured admission in the ILS Round-I (Counselling Round) and wishes to upgrade their branch as a result of the CAP round allotment are required to bring the original Fee Receipt (issued in previous round) as well as a demand draft of Rs.1000/- (branch transfer fee) at the time of admission process.**
14. List of documents is already made available on the college website.
15. Candidates seeking admission will have to personally & compulsorily be present during the reporting for admission. Only in case of a severe medical situation, will one of the parents be allowed to come and secure the admission on behalf of the candidate, that too by producing an authority letter issued by the candidate. Please note that in view of the current pandemic situation, for safety of all concerned, only the candidate will be allowed to enter the admission room. Parents may occupy seats in the canteen area on the ground floor or in a designated classroom, as per the instructions.
16. Use of face mask is compulsory and all COVID-19 precautions are to be followed by the candidate & parents.
