Admission to First Year Engineering Courses (A.Y. 2019-20) (Against CAP [Open], CAP [GCLM] & Institutional Level Vacancy Seats)

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to **First Year Engineering** courses against CAP [Open], CAP [GCLM] and Institutional Level Vacancy Seats. Online applications can be made from the 24th of July 2019 till 01st of August 2019, by using the link available on the college website.

Note:- Candidates who have already applied against our earlier notification for First Year Degree Course in Engineering at the Institute Level category need not apply again. However, candidates who may wish to be also considered separately under the GCLM (Minority) category will have to compulsorily make a fresh application.

Admission to Direct Second Year Engineering Courses (A.Y. 2019-20)

Against [CAP (Open) & GCLM (Minority)] Vacancy Seats
Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to **Direct Second Year Engineering** courses in this college against Vacancy Seats in CAP (Open) and GCLM (Minority) categories.

Applications can be made online from the 10th of August 2019 till 18th of August 2019 by using the link available on the college website.

Note:- Candidates, who wish to be considered separately under the GCLM (Minority) category will have to compulsorily make a fresh application along with the application for Open category.

Please note: An application fee of Rs. 3,540/- (Rs. 3,000/- + GST Rs. 540) per application will have to be paid at the time of making the application to both First Year & Direct Second Year admissions. The processing fee, once paid is non-refundable.

Admissions will be made on the basis of inter-se merit of candidates, who have applied to the institute in the prescribed form within the due date and on the basis of rules published in the 'Information Brochure' by the Competent Authority, Maharashtra State for admission to Undergraduate Technical Courses for the Academic Year 2019-20. Only those candidates are eligible to apply for vacancy seats, who have already applied to CAP rounds (registered with Competent Authority, Maharashtra State) and having a merit number.

For further details of Vacant Seats and Schedule of Admissions, candidates are requested to keep track of the latest information on the college website on a daily basis.
