Candidates, who have applied to this college for admission to F.E. courses and whose name appear in the final merit lists, should note that there will a counselling round (ILS) on the 12th of August 2019 to fill up the seats in the Institute level category.

Please Note: The lists to be considered will be the original Institutional Level Seats merit lists only. Students, who have applied for the vacancy round will be considered in the Vacancy Round to be held on 13th & 14th of August 2019.

state board will have to produce an additional Demand Draft/ Pay Order of Rs. 1,320/- drawn in favour of **“Dwarkadas J Sanghvi College of Engineering”** for the purpose of verification process for obtaining the eligibility from the University of Mumbai.

Please note that the list of relevant documents required for securing admission has been put up on the college website. You may note that the DD & the list of documents are to be made compulsorily available at the time of admission, without which the admission will not be offered.

Candidates are required to personally report, sharp at the reporting time given above, at the seminar hall on the 3rd floor of the college building for this counselling round.

Candidates will be called as per the merit order and if at that time, they do not possess the requested documents and the D.D./Pay Order, that particular seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate on the spot. Candidates are requested to promptly produce the required documents & the DD as applicable at the time of their admission. Please note that the presence of the candidate is mandatory for admission.

Please Note:- Candidates, who have already secured admission in the previous round (ILS) and wishes to upgrade their branch in this counselling round (subject to availability of vacancy) are required to bring the original Fee Receipt (issued in previous round) as well as a demand draft of Rs.1000/- (transfer fee) at the time of admission.

Candidates are clearly advised to note that the seat will be allotted to them, only in case a vacant seat is available as and when their turn comes. If the seats are already filled up, by the time the turn of the candidate comes in the order of merit, they will have to wait for further vacancies, if any, in the next round.
