The courses, the college will be conducting from the Academic Year 2020-21 onwards in the B.Tech Programmes with the sanctioned intake as well as the number of seats available in the ILS category are given below.

Candidates are advised to keep all the documents ready (originals + two photocopies) along with the Demand Draft /Pay Order of Rs. 1,99,826/- drawn in favour of **"Dwarkadas J Sanghvi College of Engineering"**, while reporting for admission. The exact schedule of reporting will be put up by 05.00 p.m. on the 04th of January 2021.

Candidates, who have completed their 12th standard from a board other than Maharashtra state board, will have to produce an additional Demand Draft/ Pay Order of Rs. 1,320/- drawn in favour of **"Dwarkadas J Sanghvi College of Engineering"** for the purpose of verification process for obtaining the eligibility from the University of Mumbai.

Please note that the list of relevant documents required for securing admission has already been put up on the college website. You may note that the Demand Draft/Pay Order & the list of documents are to be made compulsorily available at the time of admission, without which the admission will not be offered and the seat will be offered to the next candidate in the merit list.
