F.Y. B.Tech Admissions: 2022-23

Students, who have been allotted admissions by the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Government of Maharashtra (CAP Round-III).

1. Candidates, who have been allotted their seat through the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Government of Maharashtra: **CAP Round-III** for the Academic Year 2022-23, are required to fill in the (online) admission form, which will be available on the college website from 10th November 2022.
2. Read the instructions carefully, before filling up the form.
3. They should further note that they need to report to the college anytime between 10.00 a.m. to 01.00 p.m. or 02.00 p.m. to 04.00 p.m., from **10th November, 2022 onwards till 12th November, 2022** for completing the admission formalities.
4. Please enter the CAP registration number (EN..) and click "Continue" in the online form.
5. It then displays the options as below:
 - I. Create Application [if already applied in D.J. Sanghvi College of Engineering for Institute Level Category, click this option, enter the application number (600.....) and then click NEXT].
 - II. Create CAP/TFWS applicant [if not applied in D.J. Sanghvi College for Institute level category] (click this option and then click NEXT).
6. Please check the allotted branch and category before filling the form. In case of any discrepancy, you are instructed to report to the college.
7. Please fill in all the mandatory fields, i.e. fields marked with (*).
8. Check the information entered by you in the application form carefully, before submitting the form.
9. Once the application is submitted, no changes can be made thereafter.
10. After the submission of form, the candidate has to come to the college with required original documents + two sets of photocopies and the requisite fees payable through Demand draft/Pay order of the amount mentioned in the table given below, drawn in favour of "**Dwarkadas J. Sanghvi College of Engineering**" for confirming the admission.

11. Students belonging to various categories, such as OBC/EBC/SEBC/VJ/NT/SBC etc., should note that if their annual income is more than 8 lakhs for the financial year 2021-22, they will have to pay fees, as that of the General/GCLM category students.
12. **Candidates belonging to General/GCLM categories, who have already secured admission in the previous ILS Rounds (Counselling Round) and wishes to seek admission through the CAP round allotment are required to bring the original Fee Receipt (issued in previous round) as well as a demand draft of Rs.1000/- (branch transfer fee) at the time of admission process.**
13. **Candidates belonging to OBC/EBC/SEBC/VJ/NT/SBC/SC/ST/AICTE/TFWS categories, who have already secured admission in the previous ILS Rounds (Counselling Round) and wishes to seek admission through the CAP round allotment are required to bring Demand Draft of the Full Fees as mentioned in the above table.**
14. List of documents is already made available on the college website.
15. Candidates seeking the admission will have to come personally or else, one of the parents can come and secure the seat on behalf of the candidate, but only after producing an authority letter issued by the candidate. Please note that only the candidate or the authorised representative will be allowed to enter the admission room. Others, if any accompanying the candidate, may occupy seats in the canteen on the ground floor.

Note: Please ensure that the candidate carries the same mobile (with SIM having CET Cell registered number) on which he/she will receive the OTP from the State CET Cell during the admission process.
