Vacancy Round – IV (Spot Round)

(Open & GCLM Categories)

All eligible candidates, whose name appear in the merit lists (merit lists displayed on 09th September 2025 as well as fresh applicants list (GCLM only) as at 09.00 a.m. on 15/09/2025) are requested to note that, in anticipation of potential vacancies arising out of parallel admission rounds that may happen in various colleges, a Vacancy Round -IV (**Spot Round**) will be held in the college premises **on Monday, the 15th September 2025**, i.e., the Cut-off date of admissions. Candidates interested in participating in this round may accordingly report at the college premises for securing the admission, as available. **This round is expected to start at 11.30 a.m.**

The exact seating arrangement for candidates (as per merit order) will be displayed at the Ground floor in the morning.

The internal vacancies arising out of cancellations (due to upward movement), if any, during the round will also be filled in this round itself.

Very Very Important:

At any point in time (on 15/09/2025) during this round, if a vacancy in any of the branches arise, the same will be given to the students, who are personally present on the spot, in the order of merit. Candidates may plan to wait accordingly throughout the duration of the round, till 05.00 p.m. If the candidate is not present on the spot, no request for reconsideration will be entertained later due to the paucity of time.

Candidates are advised to keep all the documents/retention letter ready (originals + two photocopies) along with the Demand Draft /Pay Order of Rs. 2,29,625/- drawn in favour of "**Dwarkadas J. Sanghvi College of Engineering**", payable at Mumbai, while reporting for admission. All are advised to check the details of demand draft/pay order properly. If there is any error/discrepancy, it will not be accepted and no other mode of payment will be strictly entertained at any cost. DD/PO order is strictly compulsory.

Please Note:- Candidates, who have already secured admission in either of the CAP rounds (I/II/III/IV) or Vacancy Rounds (I/II/III) and have paid the fees of amount Rs. 2,29,625/- and wishes to further change their branch in this Spot round (subject to availability of vacancy and the application made) are required to bring the original Fee Receipt (issued in previous round), original Document Retention Certificate, original CET Cell Admission Letter as well as cash/Demand Draft of Rs.1000/- (transfer fee) at the time of admission.

Please Note:- Candidates belonging to OBC / EBC / VJ / NT / SBC / SEBC / SC / ST / TFWS categories, who have already secured admission in either of the CAP Rounds I, II, III or IV and wishes to further change the branch and seek admission through the vacancy round are compulsorily required to bring a fresh Demand Draft of the Full Fees of Rs. 2,29,625/- at the time of admission. They may note that there is no fee concession permissible in the vacancy rounds for all categories of students, as per the guidelines of CET Cell, Maharashtra.

Please note that the list of relevant documents required for securing admission has already been put up on the college website.

All are required to report sharp at the college premises as per the reporting time given above for this Spot round.



Candidates will be called as per the merit number and if at that time, they do not possess the required documents and the D.D./Pay Order, that particular seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate on the spot. Candidates are requested to promptly produce the required documents/retention letter & DD, as applicable at the time of their admission.

Candidates are clearly advised to note that the seat will be allotted to them, only in case a vacant seat is available as and when their turn comes. If the seats are already filled up, by the time the turn of the candidate comes in the order of merit, they will have to wait for further vacancies, if any.

Please Note: candidates seeking the admission will have to come personally or else, one of the parents can come and secure the seat on behalf of the candidate, but only after producing an authority letter issued by the candidate. Please note that only the candidate or the authorised representative will be allowed to enter the admission room. Others, if any accompanying the candidate, may occupy seats in the canteen on the ground floor.

Also, please note that the candidate, who secures admission in this round will necessarily have to pay Rs. 1,000/- as seat acceptance fees to the State CET Cell on their portal (online), if not already paid.

Important: **Please ensure that the candidate carries the same mobile (with SIM having CET Cell registered number) on which he/she will receive the OTP from the State CET Cell during the admission process.**
