The eligible students, who wish to avail the EBC/OBC/SBC/VJNT/SEBC/SC/ST scholarship benefit during the Academic Year 2026-27, will have to submit the below mentioned self-attested documents in college office as per the following schedule.

**Documents Required: (should be arranged in the following serial nos.)**

- 1) Application in the prescribed format.
- 2) DTE CAP allotment cum admission letter (Final Admission in DJSCCE with college stamp).
- 3) **Original Income certificate from Tahasildar office for financial year 2025-26. (Annual Income less than Rs.8.00 lakhs. Except SC/ST)**  
\*If Income certificate is not in the name of the father, relevant documents like: father's death certificate/Divorce paper are additionally required.
- 4) **Original Affidavit/Undertaking in a prescribed format on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper ([Format for Undertaking Link](#)).**
- 5) Photocopy of Ration card for identifying the number of children in family, as only 2 children are eligible for the scholarship benefit.
- 6) Declaration Certificate of parents/guardians about the number of children beneficiaries (Format on MAHADBT Portal).
- 7) Marksheet of Previous year (self-attested copy).
- 8) Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra State.
- 9) Aadhar seeded Bank account details of student along with Passbook 1<sup>st</sup> page copy and Mobile Number in a prescribed format ([Bank details format link](#)).
- 10) Aadhar card copy.

**Schedule for documents submission: - From 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2026. (Between 10:00 am to 01:00 pm and 02:00 pm to 04:00 pm - office 1<sup>st</sup> floor - counter no. -5)**

All the self-attested documents submitted in the college will be verified and the outcome of verification of the acceptance or rejection will be conveyed to the students. Accordingly, students will have to pay the college fees as per verification outcome of their application.

Those students who receive email from college for payment of half fees and fail to submit the documents for verification will have to pay the entire fees to the college as prescribed by the Fees Regulatory Authority (FRA).
